

The Service CU Impact Foundation promotes community development by funding initiatives that deliver solutions and solve problems facing our membership and communities in which we serve.

The foundation funds initiatives beyond what Service CU supports, broadening the community reach and having a larger impact. We conduct charitable activities and partner with service providers who align with our philanthropic areas of focus: education, human services, and emergency care for veterans and military.



Scholarships – The Impact Foundation awarded over \$50,000 in scholarships to 16 deserving individuals.

2nd Annual Service CU Impact Foundation Golf Charity Classic – In partnership with the Robert Irvine Foundation, the 2nd annual golf tournament raised nearly \$350,000 for veterans, military, and first responders locally and worldwide.



Holiday Giving Overseas

Every year Service CU expresses gratitude for its military communities by providing the US military a bit of home at their duty station during the holiday seasons. In partnership with the Garrison, 1st Sergeants Association and the USO, the credit union distributed gift cards and provided frozen turkeys and monetary support to go towards free meals at the USO Welcome Centers and military dining facilities during the holidays, and also helped cut and distribute Christmas trees for military families:

- 120 \$50 Visa Gift Cards
- 650 Frozen Turkeys
- 675 Holiday Meals
- 300 Christmas Trees
- 500 Christmas Ornaments
