Supporting Our Military Through Sponsorship and Partnership:

Military Spouse of the Month – Service CU has been recognizing the sacrifices of our military spouses, choosing one winner every month to receive \$500, with an additional \$500 being donated to a nonprofit of the spouse's choosing.

Swim With a Mission – Presenting sponsor, helping to raise millions of dollars for military and veteran organizations.

NH Fisher Cats – Tip of the Cap sponsor, recognizing military members in attendance at all games.

NH Children's Museum – Presenting sponsor of the Blue Star Museum program, which provides free admission for active military personnel and their families from Armed Forces Day, in May, through Labor Day each September. In 2023, CMNH admitted 1,430 people with the Blue Star Museum discount. Additionally, this sponsorship provides a 50% discount to active military personnel and veterans, and their families from January – October. In 2023, the museum admitted 380 visitors using this discount.

Holiday Giving:

Overseas:

- 679 service members and their families were served holiday meals
- · 148 turkeys distributed
- 304 \$25 Visa® gift cards distributed for holiday meals
- 122 Christmas trees donated to active duty military
- 880 welcome bags packed and distributed to service members in partnership with the USO

Stateside:

Presenting sponsor of GATHER Thanksgiving – 1,435 individuals and 489 families served. 472 turkeys, 875 pies, endless canned and fresh produce totaling over 22,629 pounds of food distributed.

Stay Warm – For the 4th year in a row, Service CU distributed Stay Warm bags packed with a hat, scarf, gloves, and a blanket that were given to 35 nonprofits for distribution in their local communities. Service CU has distributed a total of 21,000 bags.

Project Elf – Now in its second year, Service CU elves shopped at 11 locally owned NH toy stores, purchasing over 4,000 toys, spending over \$80,000 to donate to the NH State Police Toys for Tots effort.

Branch Drives – U.S. branches held individual collection drives for local nonprofits, collecting nearly 5,000 items.

Adopt a Nonprofit – All NH branches chose a local Nonprofit to make a holiday donation to, helping with wish list items.

Lunch with Joe Cardona – Service CU treated nearly 80 veterans with a free lunch with New England star and Navy Lieutenant Joe Cardona.

American Red Cross Overseas Association Annual Banquet – The credit union hosted a very special 72nd annual banquet for a group of women from the American Red Cross Overseas Association who served from World War II on as Donut Dollies and nurses.

Special Olympics NH Cornhole Tournament – In October, Service CU hosted an inaugural cornhole tournament where nearly 40 Special Olympic Athletes were paired to Service CU staff. The day ended in a \$10,000 donation to the Special Olympics.

Veteran Sails – Provided free gundalow rides for veterans with the NH Gundalow Company.

USO Care Pack – More than 30 Service CU staff volunteered to join the USO in packing kits for deployed soldiers, providing a taste of home with favorite snacks and highly requested comfort items, at the USS Constitution Museum in Boston.
